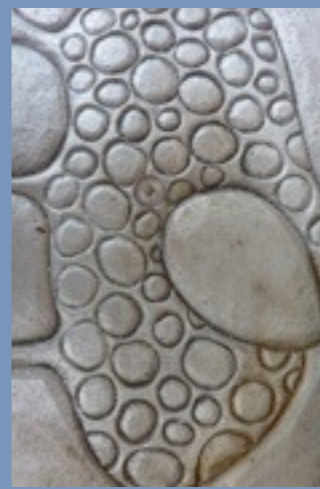

Current projects underway

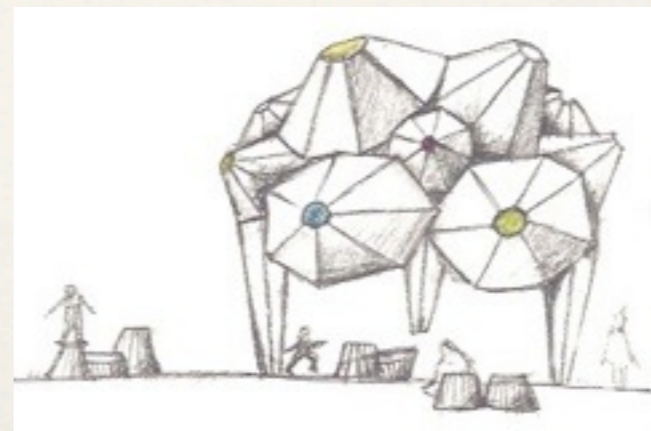
Designs for retail Kiosks: Working with silversmith Owen Waterhouse to produce designs for Artworks for 'the Moor' relating to Sheffield's metalworking heritage in the heart of Sheffield's retail quarter. Scottish Widdows Partnership.

Barnsley Cat: Large cat sculpture for a gateway traffic island in Barnsley Town Centre. Working with a local primary school to produce poetry relating to the Alhambra Theatre cat. Barnsley MBC.

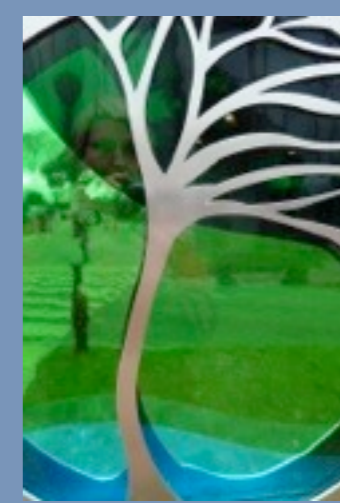
Courtyard: Private commission for sculptural mosaic.

27 Park entrances: 2011 Brinkburn Denes Parks, Darlington. Working with the Friends of the Denes and Owen Waterhouse to create designs for six different areas of the park. Fabricated by Mayflower engineering Ltd.



1930's Sofa and Lamp: Cosy shelter (collaboration with Amanda Wray) mild steel and mosaic Osgathorpe Park, Pitsmoor, Sheffield.



Windswept Tree: Arbourthorne School, Sheffield 2005. 7m wide stainless steel tree and cascade of leaves.



Relaxing in the flowers: 4m wide stainless steel figure in mosaic flowerbed. Workshops to produce mosaic bollards for community garden.



Leaf shelter: Sandhill Primary School Barnsley, 6m x 4m leaf shaped shelter. An outdoor classroom, parents shelter and adventures at playtime. Leaf roof in galvanized mild steel with cast glass caterpillars eating it. Cast aluminium animal feet. Designed with artist Jason Thomson.



Obelisk -Sheffield. For Great Places Housing assoc. 3m tall stainless steel with mosaic. Consultation with local TARA and residents.

Jaguar gates: Firs Hill School, Pitsmoor, Sheffield. Stainless steel with glass inserts. Paperweight style glass inserts for spots. 6m x 2m.



Meadow View Mosaics: Inspired by pupils ideas during transition to new school building. Stainless steel and mosaic.

From Natures Table: Sheffield. **Weston Park museum**, 2006. Two curved mosaic benches, images from the city collection inspired by nature.

Memorial Sculpture: 2012 Working with a bereaved family to create a memorial at **Rotherham Hospital**.

Monkey Fence: with primate images made from Stainless Steel. **30m ellipse of 2m high fence** in Wade Street Open Space, Sheffield.

Pebble Mosaic for Sculpture Garden: Ropewalk Gallery, Linear mosaic floor panel using natural stone pebbles. **Barton-on-Humber**. 2007

Riddle trail Mosaic: The Pavillion, **Botanical Gardens Sheffield**.

Cunning Mural: Carved brick mural 3m x 2m, **Hadleigh Library**, Essex.

Mosaic Garden: Tonge Moor estate, Bolton.

Snake seat: 6m long mosaic and mild steel snake bench for courtyard. Pye Bank School, Burngreave, Sheffield 2004

Hand: 5ft long cast iron Hand, Community centre Ashton-u-line, Thameside 2003. Ideas came from youth group members.

Giant Tortoise and Friends: Swinton Open Space Rotherham 2003. Large cast iron animals and concrete snake maze. **Groundwork Dearne Valley**.

Flying Carpet: Sharrow Junior School stainless steel bench in the shape of a flying carpet covered in mosaic + mosaic panels by each year group. 2003

Dinosaur: 9m long, mild steel, Phoenix Park Thurnscoe, Rotherham.

Bingo: 5m² mosaic gable wall of **Irwell Valley housing Association** flats, Bury, Lancs.

Giraffe Basketball: Painted Mild steel, Graves Park Sheffield. 1998.

Trade Union Banner: 2012 Sheffield Mental Health **Citizen's Advice Bureau**. Design of banner for exhibitions and marches. 2012.

Hive: Nether Green Junior School. Large cast iron Bee 2.5m x .5m. Mosaics produced by children to form honeycomb panels for the walls. 2011.

School of Fish Gates: Main entrance gates to Firs Hill School, Pitsmoor. Large fish with cast glass panels. Smaller fish drawn by the pupils of the school council laser cut and applied to the gates. 2011.
