**Profile** I live in Sheffield and work from my city centre studio within the artists community of Yorkshire Artspace. I have a clean driving licence and have no criminal convictions.

**Experience** I have 28 years experience of working as an Artist making public art, projects often involve working with student accommodation developers, communities within Schools, Hospitals, Parks or Regeneration projects. I have worked closely with architects, structural engineers, fabricators and contractors to produce meaningful artwork for the public realm from Essex to Darlington.

**Skills** My work demonstrates a high degree of craftsmanship in its production and is good value for money. I design metal artworks for fabrication, make formers for metal casting and have excellent making skills in mosaic, glass and ceramic. I have good organisational and people skills and I am very at ease when talking to the public. I regularly chair meetings for my fellow artists at Yorkshire Artspace.

**Interests** I enjoy hikes and leisurely bike rides with my children and friends. I am interested in Geological and biological forms. I am part of the committee of BAMB a national group of mosaic artists. When I get time I like to knit socks.

## Selected Example projects:

- **Anne Knight and the dawn of the women's movement in the UK:** 20m2 contemporary Mosaic using ceramic, oak and etched brass to highlight the timeline of Anne Knight's inspiration and influence. Main wall of reception foyer in new 17 storey iQ Student Accommodation building in Sheffield.
- **Ulley Country Park Mosaic:** 4m long mosaic commission to commemorate the near disaster in 2007 and 25 circular mosaics made with community groups.
- **Triangles:** 25 framed artworks by patients and artists, Seiko Kinoshita, Coralie Turpin and Jason Thomson. For Sheffield's Northern general Hospital Spinal Injuries Unit.
- **Sparks and crags:** 10m x 2m stainless steel and bronze artwork for Hannah court student accommodation.
- **Aldi Jitterbug:** 2m high double sided mosaic sculpture to commemorate the Old Drill Hall in Eckington. Workshops for one side with Ecclesfield School. Commissioned by Aldi with Junction Arts.
- **27 Park entrances:** Brinkburn Denes Parks, Darlington. Working with the Friends of the Denes, schools, brownies, sixth formers etc. to create designs for six different areas of the park.
- **Designs for retail Kiosks 7 large screens:** 'The Moor' Sheffield. Working with silversmith Owen Waterhouse. Aberdeen Asset Management.
- **Barnsley Cat:** Gateway sculpture, Barnsley Town Centre. Working with a local primary school to produce poetry relating to the Alhambra Theatre cat. Barnsley MBC.
- **Leaf shelter:** Sandhill Primary School Barnsley, 6m x 4m leaf shaped shelter. Mild steel with cast glass caterpillars. Cast aluminium animal feet. Designed with Artist Jason Thomson and pupils.
- **Bingo and cars:** 6m2 mosaic for a Irwell Valley Housing association building in Bury.
- **Mosaic Garden:** 4 large floor mosaics and garden design for a sensory garden for Bolton % for Art.
